The Virginia Library Association (VLA) Scholarship Committee's scholarship opportunity is designed to recognize and support outstanding individuals committed to advancing the field of library science.

We are proud to award two scholarships, each valued at \$3,000, to deserving recipients who embody the spirit of excellence and dedication to the library profession.

Students must be pursuing a Master's degree in Library Science at an ALA-accredited school and must be currently enrolled or have received acceptance for the 2026-2027 academic year.

Please note that this application requires two (2) references that must be uploaded with your application. One (1) of the two (2) references is strongly recommended to be a librarian or other information professional. You must also include an undergraduate transcript, as well as a letter of acceptance to an ALA accredited graduate program or graduate academic transcript. Unofficial transcripts are accepted. All files must be PDFs.

There is a written component to the application - **please plan accordingly when filling out the form as your progress will not be saved.**

You may be required to create a Google account to upload files to this form.
