## What is a drop-in program?

- Conveys information
- Requires little to no staff guidance
- Patrons participate at their leisure



## **Types of Drop-in Programs/ Ideas**

- Displays
- Guessing contests
- Interactive displays
- Coloring contests
- Voting

• Crafts

- Scavenger hunts
- Themed days
- Raffles
- Social media contests

## Pros

Usually requires no staff or limited staff supervision

Costs tend to be lower

Execute more programs per month

May reach non-traditional program participants

## Cons

May require increased planning and prep. time

Patrons are not always as actively involved in the programming

Can be difficult to track participation
