








Comparable Data

Types of Questions to Ask

Student Assistants

- If they are returning student workers – compare to last year?
- What do you feel was more successful?
- What motivated you more?
- What aspects should be changed to make it better for you?
- What do you feel like you mostly got out of the program?
- What should I do differently next year?

Library Staff

- How effective is the students work?
- What good and bad things have you observed?
- What do you feel should change?
