









C. **Budget:** Please prepare a budget for your grant proposal showing planned expenses in as much detail as possible.


Note: The ADP does not pay for food served at receptions or equipment already owned by Longwood University.

Tips & Tricks

Research, Research, Research

- Tons of resources available
- Check for previous recipients

Writing

- Multiple drafts
- Co-worker input & revisions
- Use boldface and italics to make key terms stand out.
- Simple but entertaining

Proofread, then Proofread again

- Seriously
- Check deadlines & submission requirements



Finding Grants



Tips

- Check with different departments about what grants they may have available
- Universities typically have some internal grants for staff
- Weekly emails to faculty and staff
- ListServs from VLA and ALA and other organizations.
