From the Membership meeting:

- ALA is undertaking 3 key strategic initiatives this fiscal year, **ALA Forward** will include:
 - (1) an Organizational Assessment led by Westman and Associates that will examine our internal processes and structures to ensure operational excellence,
 - (2) a Program Assessment, reviewing the impact and value of our individual programs and,
 - (3) Strategic Planning, a deep dive into refining our mission and goals led by the ALA Executive Board and consultants with the Association Management Center.
- James W. Lewis of Washington, D.C. has made the largest individual bequest to the American Library Association in the association's history. The approximately \$25 million bequest is truly transformational and will fund scholarships for aspiring librarians.
- As of October 2024 statistics, the total ALA membership count stands at 47,247, compared to 47,948 for October 2023. This represents an overall decrease of 1.46%.
- New membership model with simplified cost structure.
- Public Partner Program launch in early 2025
